Sami Rintala is guest professor at the Department for Building Theory by Design in Summer Semester 2016. The Finnish architect is well known for his works that are balancing between art and architecture, always deeply rooted with the place, satisfying basic needs, offering simplicity, natural beauty and authenticity. His understanding of teaching and working hands-on in 1:1 as key aspect of his work fosters staying in contact with places, materials and people.

The Master Entwerfen 'Workshop 1:1 Floridsdorf' takes place in the 21st Viennese District Floridsdorf on Schlingermarkt – a market square embraced by a historic social housing superblock of the Interwar period. Although the market has seen better days and is run down to a certain extent, it is nonetheless part of a lively and unpretentious neighborhood that seeks to find its place in the Vienna of today.

In a two-week-workshop, students will design, plan, realize and utilize a site-specific architectonic intervention on Schlingermarkt, that reacts to its surroundings and social processes, making it less of a sculpture, but more of an urban element that uses the qualities of the site and that can be used by everyone.
